Product Strategy & Discovery

- Using Google Vertex AI and Google's ADK (Agent Development Kit), led development of four distinct generative and agentic AI features. This set of features makes it easier for marketers to convert their rough ideas into real, functional customer journeys by giving them a prompt that will coach them through the process of making their ideas reality. One of these features – “AI Journeys” – reduced the time required for customers to create engagement journeys by 83%, reducing their time-to-market dramatically.
- Served as the engineering lead of the “Product Trio” for Airship's \$25M ARR Journeys product, used by 80 enterprise customers and 10M+ end users. Led dozens of product discovery efforts, ensuring technical feasibility while shaping innovative solutions. Launch of this product drove \$3.5M revenue in its first six months, strengthening competitiveness against Braze and Salesforce.
- Led discovery and phased, agile delivery of the “Approval Workflow” feature, solving approval process problems for 90% of customers with just ~10% of the originally forecast development effort. This lean, data-validated approach unlocked earlier transition to higher-value initiatives, accelerating our roadmap and increasing ROI on engineering time.

Championed incremental, high-value releases on tight timelines—using feature flags, demos, and direct customer feedback to keep development tightly aligned with evolving product strategy and user needs.
- Drove our transition from a waterfall-derived process to an agile-inspired one, enabling our product team to shift from long, opaque release cycles to incremental, demoable weekly deliveries. This empowered product leaders with the tactical flexibility to align daily execution with strategic goals, ensuring we validate and refine the right product long before major engineering investment or marketing commitments.
- Mentored junior engineers, providing technical guidance, code reviews, and career support to accelerate their growth and impact within the team and on their career in general.

- **Obsidian Local REST API with MCP** — *Obsidian Plugin*
 - Developed and maintain a REST API and Model Context Protocol (MCP) server plugin for the Obsidian notetaking platform, enabling programmatic and AI-agent access to a user's personal knowledge base.
 - Reached 673k downloads via the [Obsidian community plugin marketplace](#), with 2.8k GitHub stars – one of the most widely adopted Obsidian plugins.
- **Recall for Obsidian (formerly Obsidian Web)** — *Browser Extension*
 - Developed “Recall for Obsidian,” a browser extension on the [Chrome Web Store](#) that helps roughly 20k users of the Obsidian notetaking tool surface, understand and create connections between online content and notes in their “second brain”.
